3 Easy Steps to Make Your Vote Count:

- 1. Make sure you're registered.
- 2. Know when, where, and how to vote.
- 3. What's on YOUR ballot?



STUDENT VOTING RIGHTS

- 1. **Register** at campus residence or "home."
- 2. **Vote on campus**. Campus voting supports student access and is the easiest way to make YOUR VOTE COUNT!
- 3. **OR** vote by mail at "home" residence.**Requires you to closely follow details, deadlines and mailing times to make your vote count.

- Your registration card must be delivered by mail to verify your address. Arrives in ~ 3 weeks. Use the lookup tool to verify and see your sample ballot!

- If you don't see yourself on the lookup in October, GO TO EARLY VOTING TO USE SAME DAY REGISTRATION!
